For three days in June, Christ Church Cathedral will be decked with thousands of flowers as part of ***Gloria! A Festival of Flowers***, our sesquicentennial gift to the people of Ottawa.

Gloria! an expanded version of our annual **Doors Open Ottawa** event, will run June 2-4, 2017. **Doors Open** is the weekend every year when local buildings invite citizens to visit for free and learn about their city's heritage through its architecture. This year, our traditional Doors Open tours, focused on the history and architecture of our 185-year-old parish and Victorian building will be just the beginning of what's happening over the weekend.

Thousands of blossoms in dozens of arrangements will fill the church in the red, yellow and orange colours of Pentecost, which falls on Sunday, June 4. If you would like music with your flowers, there will be two concerts in the Cathedral on Saturday: at 11 a.m. (the Nepean Songsters) and 2 p.m. (the Strings of the Central Band of the Canadian Armed Forces).

Displays in the crypt will feature Royal memorabilia and samples of the Cathedral's beautiful needlework. As well, there will be a tearoom and boutique running in the Great Hall. Because of our special celebration, we're running longer than the official Doors Open Ottawa hours — the Cathedral will be open for visitors from 2 to 7 p.m. Friday June 2, from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. Saturday June 3, and from noon to 4 p.m. Sunday June 4.
