The Anglican Church is happy to be part of your wedding and to offer you the opportunity to attend a marriage preparation workshop.

Our Marriage Preparation Course is designed to help participants to learn and to grow, both individually and as a couple. Opportunities for such learning and growth are created through the talks given by professional speakers, small group work with trained facilitators, and time for couples to share with each other.

ABOUT THE COURSE

The five topics covered in this course include Values and Expectations, Communication, Conflict Resolution Styles, Vulnerability/Intimacy and Sexuality in Marriage, and Christian Marriage.

Expect to have a better time than you think you will! This course, while based on solid research, is laid-back and fun. Based on feedback, over 95% of the attendees were satisfied with the course, with the vast majority rating the course as “excellent” or “very good.”

Upon completion of the course, you are provided with a “Certificate of Participation” and a letter to give to the person officiating at your wedding.

To receive a “Certification of Participation” couples must attend all parts of the course. Under certain circumstances, arrangements can be made for couples to attend parts of two courses. Please contact the Registrar to make this request.

We also offer a Marriage and Step-Parenting Preparation Course. See separate brochure or website for details.

FEES AND WHAT TO BRING

The fee is \$160 per couple. This includes a 10 hour course, a resource book and light refreshments.

Please bring yourselves and an open mind and heart.

Lunch will not be provided. You may either bring your own bag lunch or go to a nearby restaurant. We are trying to be more environmentally friendly, so please bring a travel mug if you have one.
