



Diocesan Wide Youth Internship Program (YIP)

The YIP committee will be awarding internships in its Youth Internship Program for the 2018 academic year. The internships will be awarded to students wanting to engage in the development of their faith and leadership skills and to obtain valuable hands-on experience in a variety of placement opportunities within the parishes of the Anglican Diocese of Ottawa and our community partners.

This program is made possible by the partnership between Trinity Bank Street, St James Manotick and the Anglican Diocese of Ottawa.

The Program:

Successful applicants will commit themselves to the following components of the program:

1. Four Faith Formation sessions led by the Faith Formation team of the Reverends Kerri Brennan, Geoffrey Chapman and Rhonda Waters and the coordinator Donna Rourke
2. Two Leadership development seminars led by a variety of expert facilitators, covering topics such as leadership styles, difficult conversations, conflict resolution, and social justice. Leadership seminars will develop and support personal and professional development.
3. Community work site placements of 2 hours per week within the Diocese or with one of our partner organizations. Community placement options include, but not limited to: CLAY*, DYC**, youth ministry leadership, children's ministry, communications, and/or as a link between parishes, the Diocese and community agencies such as KAIROS, the Food Bank, Citizens for Public Justice, Centre 454
4. A relationship with a Christian mentor
5. An intentional coaching relationship with the coordinator that includes weekly contact with her.

Interns are expected to worship regularly at a church and be a visible part of the faith community. The total time commitment is not expected to exceed 5 hours a week during the academic year.

Successful applicants over 18 years of age may be required to provide a police records check.

Successful applicants under 18 years of age must have a signed consent from their parents or guardian and consent to text and photo and video.

The Application and Placement Process:

1. Complete the application form and return to Donna Rourke by email (donna-rourke@ottawa.anglican.ca) or youth@stjames-manotick.org. Applications will be accepted now and until November 25, 2017. Applicants must be in Grade 11 – 1st year University or College
2. All applicants will be notified to come in for a panel interview. Interviews will be arranged. Interns will meet with Donna in December and early January to learn more about the program, discern their gifts and passions, and discuss work site placement opportunities.
3. Interns will receive an honorarium of \$50.00 at the beginning of the term in January \$150.00 in April and \$300.00 upon successful participation of the program
